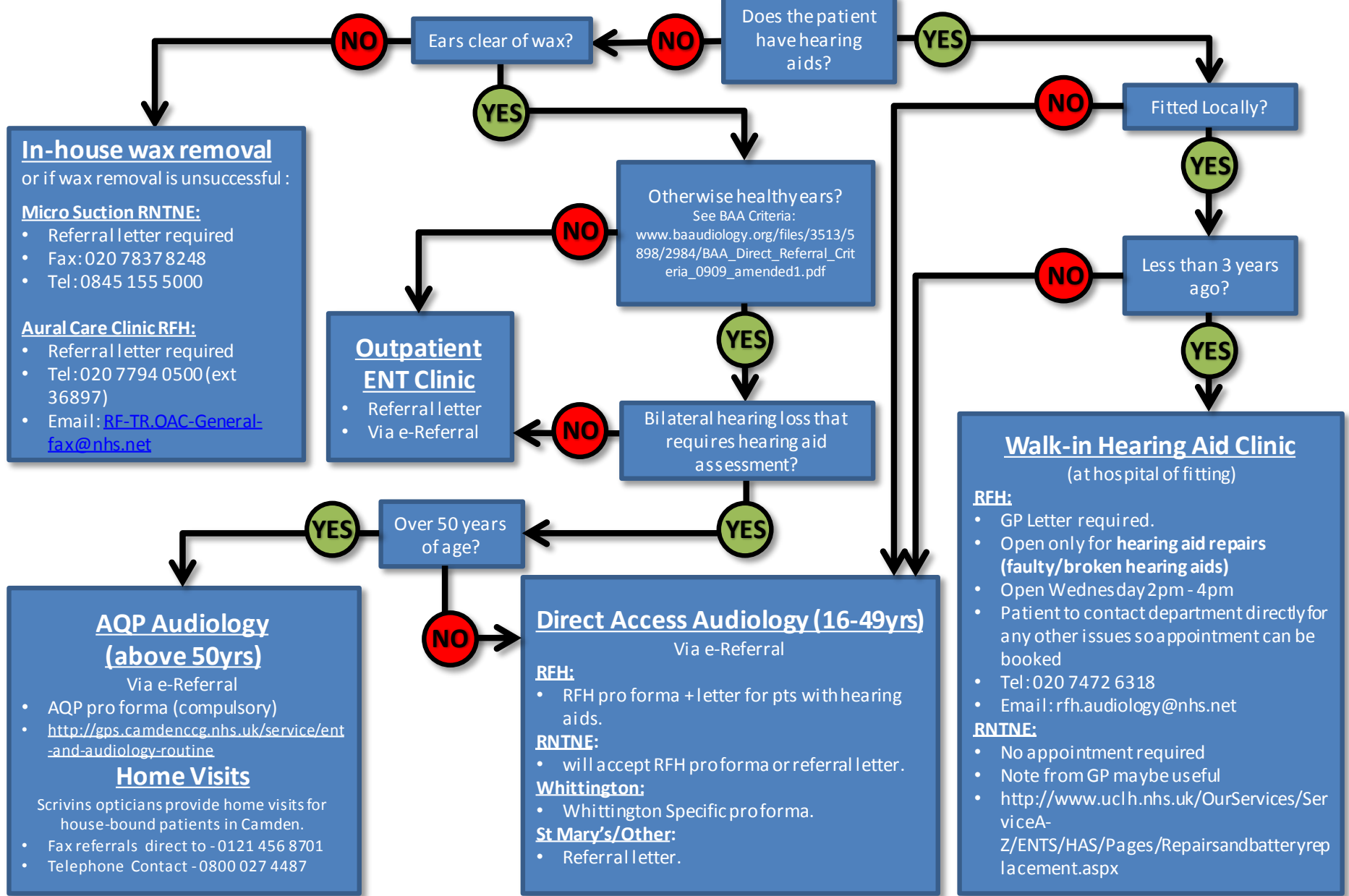

- GP Letter required.
- Open only for **hearing aid repairs (faulty/broken hearing aids)**
- Open Wednesday 2pm - 4pm
- Patient to contact department directly for any other issues so a appointment can be booked
