

Fact File 18: Using CEG search Post COVID-19 Audit

CEG have built a search to support the CCG Post Covid-19 Audit. Practices are requested to run the search and then review the patients identified by the search that meet the inclusion criteria.

The CEG search identifies patients aged 18 and over with first/new episode of suspected or confirmed COVID-19 recorded in their patient record. Practices are then asked to review their patients who fulfil the inclusion criteria

Inclusion Criteria

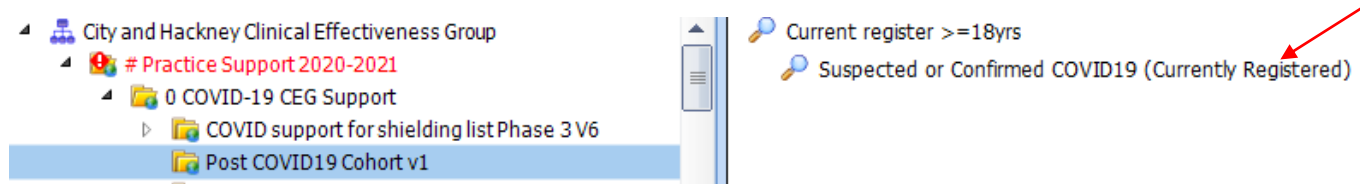
- Currently registered Adult patients with a Covid code entered on their EMIS records
- Patients whose symptoms persist after 14 days with further GP consult (the duration of the symptoms will be calculated from the first to most recent consultation)

Exclusion Criteria

- Patients whose symptoms resolve within 14 days
- Those admitted to hospital or attended A&E for COVID related symptoms

Location of Search

In EMIS population reporting select Clinical Effectiveness Group Domain. The search is in the folder below:



Copy the folder to your own practice domain and run the search. Use the patient included tab to identify patients to review.
